Planning permission is sought by EirGrid Plc under Planning Register Reference P23/195 in the townlands of Ballyartney, Ballygeery East, Ballygeery West, Cloonkerry West, Cullenagh, Kilkerin, Killofin, Knockphutten and Lakyle North, Co Clare. The proposed development applied for consists of the following: (1) An extension of the existing Kilklerin Point 220 kV Line Cable Interface Mast (LCIM) compound, to facilitate new electrical equipment for the connection of two new 220 kV cable circuits, including: (a) A new control cabin (approximately 13.4sqm floor area by 3.5m high, which includes 0.85m ground clearance) and 2 no. parking spaces; (b) Associated 220 kV electrical equipment including, cable sealing ends, insulators, overhead conductors, surge arrestors and lightning masts measuring 15m high (tallest compound structure); (c) 220 kV underground cabling from the associated underground transition pits to the cable sealing end equipment; palisade fencing (approximately 2.6m in height, up to 3.5m in height, including anti-climb device) and gates; and associated landscaping. The development will also comprise: (2) A new fibre optic cable measuring an approximate length of 8.9km routed between Kilklerin Point LCIM compound (townland of Lakyle North) and Prospect 220 kV substation (townland of Ballygeery West); (3) Decommissioning of existing 220 kV electrical equipment, security fencing and gate at Kilklerin Point 220 kV compound; and (4) All ancillary site development works including site preparation works, site clearance and levelling, handstanding, internal access tracks and temporary construction compound. The planning application is accompanied by a Natura Impact Statement (NIS). - A 110/33kV substation consisting of 2no control buildings, a transformer compound, a high voltage (HV) switchgear compound, a customer MV compound and associated cabling. The control buildings will consist of foundation works, block work, roofing, low voltage electrical fit out, medium voltage switchgear cladding and building finishing works.
- 2no underground 110kV cables, a cable access track and 2no overhead line towers.
- A power transformer, HV electrical equipment (4bay). Overhead line gantry, lightning protection masts, communication mast, structural steel works, circuit breakers, current transformers, voltage transformers, busbars, surge arresters, cable sealing ends, disconnectors/earth switches, surge arrestors and post insulators will be installed in the Eirgrid HV Substation Compound.
- The Customer MV Compound will consist of 2 No. capacitor banks, 1 No. reactor banks and associated circuit breakers (capacitor and reactor), 1 no. harmonic filter, resistor, pre-insertion resistor and 1 No. auxiliary transformer.
- Palisade and concrete post and rail fencing will be erected around the compound for security/protection. This application is a new 110kV Substation to feed into the existing Drumline-Ennis 110kV overhead line (OHL) circuit. The Substation and 110kV loop in infrastructure is situated within lands at Coolshamroge, Ennis, Co. Clare. The Substation is to facilitate the Manusmore Solar Farm (PA Ref:20562), the Manusmore Solar Farm Extension (PA Ref:21915) and the Coolshamrock Solar Farm (PA Ref:22586).
